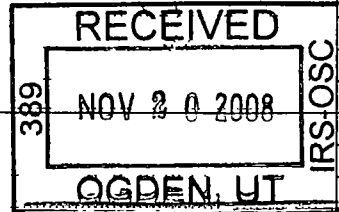

Connected Nation, Inc. lobbied with and/or through its subsidiary ConnectKentucky, LLC for technology assessment, direct funding, and education technology. In addition, the following Kentucky bills or resolutions were lobbied:

Kentucky Senate Bill 74

There was a measure to create a new section of KRS Chapter 147A to promote the deployment of broadband infrastructure and other information technologies within the Governor's Department for Local Government (GOLD). Under the terms of the bill, GOLD would:

- Encourage the deployment of broadband and information technology as well as the adoption of such technologies throughout Kentucky.
- Serve as a resource for all citizens, broadband providers, technology businesses and government agencies;
- Report progress on broadband deployment to LRC upon request and on an annual basis, and
- Ensure that the public is notified about funds that are available for broadband and IT investments before any contracts or grants are awarded.

The measure would also specifically recognize the work and accomplishments of the ConnectKentucky partnership.

Kentucky House Concurrent Resolution 126

As recommended by the Kentucky Broadband Task Force, this measure would recognize ConnectKentucky as the Commonwealth's information technology resource. The measure would help facilitate ConnectKentucky's work so that the organization may continue to improve technology access and adoption by:

- 1 Working with providers and relevant government agencies to ensure adequate investments in information technology and telecommunications for keeping Kentucky competitive;
2. Tracking technology progress and reporting regularly to the Legislative Research Commission to address constituent concerns and questions regarding information technology and telecommunications;
3. Providing additional information related to competitive access and availability for increased broadband adoption based upon data collected at the county level;
4. Assessing and evaluating the need for state-of-the-art emerging technologies for providing world-class Internet service in key economic areas of the Commonwealth where broadband technologies should be upgraded, and
- 5 Granting the leadership of ConnectKentucky discretion to pursue the recommendations of the Kentucky Broadband Task Force and this resolution according to the resources available to the organization and in light of the fast-paced dynamics of the competitive broadband marketplace.
