Administrative Order No. 2013-WW-07 (Order) was issued to the above parties (Joint Use Cities) on March 14, 2013. It was amended twice, with the most recent amendment on September 27, 2019. That amendment and Order is hereby amended as follows all other portions of the order remain in full force and effect:

1. Section V ORDER paragraphs 11 through 18 are replaced with the following:
 11. By February 28, 2022, the Joint Use Cities shall complete construction of disinfection at Outfall #001.
 12. The Joint Use Cities shall commit to annual improvements to the Inflow and Infiltration of the collection system of an average of \$3,000,000.00 or more annually from 2020 to 2026 (reference City of Davenport Capital Improvement Plan).

13. Beginning April 1, 2021, and continuing through April 1, 2034, the Joint Use Cities shall submit yearly progress reports to the DNR, due by April 1st of each year, detailing progress toward compliance with this Order and documenting the projects and expenditures for all I&I reduction projects.


14. By January 1, 2023, present construction documents (Phase 1) of a flood mitigation project for the Water Pollution Control Plant. The purpose of flood mitigation is to protect the mechanical assets in the event of a catastrophic flood and improve access to the facility during flood events exceeding 19.5 feet as measured by the Rock Island Mississippi River flood gauge.

15. By April 1, 2025, commence work on Phase 2 of the flood mitigation project. Phase 2 is defined as construction of the East and South berm system, storm water equalization and storm water control station.

16. By November 1, 2026 complete work on Phase 2 of the flood mitigation project.

17. By July 1, 2030, Joint Use Cities shall submit a report to the department detailing the feasibility and reasonableness of disinfection for outfall #801 and the feasibility and reasonableness of treatment of wet weather flows.

18. By July 1, 2034, Joint Use Cities shall complete construction of disinfection at Outfall #801.
