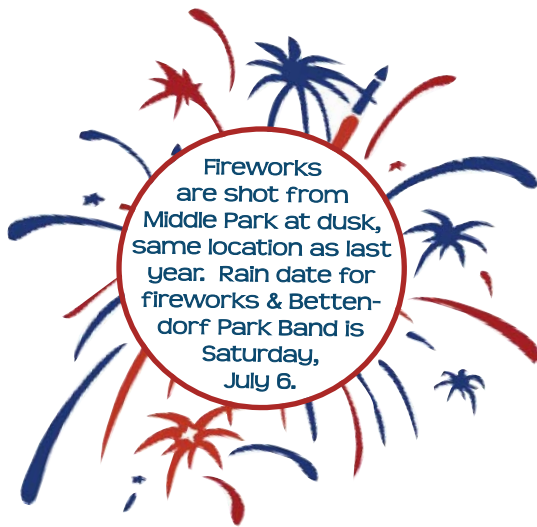
Meet This Year's Parade Marshal
